- 8. The Australian Constitution is the set of legal principles by which Australia is governed.
- 9. It was passed as a British Act of Parliament in 1900. It came into force on 1 January 1901.
- 10. Australia is a democracy as every Member of Parliament is elected by the citizens, as a representative of the people to make decisions and laws for the nation.
